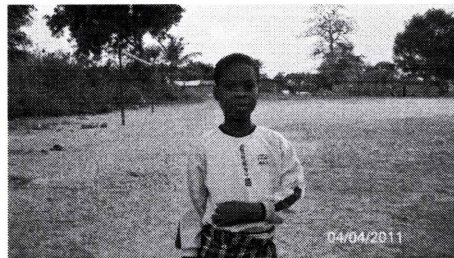
A Day in the Life...

I present to you, Lucy. She is a 12 year old girl in Primary 4, which is fourth grade.



Lucy’s life is that of an average Akrampa child. Her day starts with fetching water for her home and family. She would then sweep the yard surrounding her home and clean up the fireplace where the previous day’s dinner was cooked.



When all this is done, she would have her bath-the bathhouse is in the open at the back of her home-get dressed and go to school.
